# Why 3 Global Sessions?

- To create a longer time period for our community to participate
  - More sessions means more of our community can join in a time that is convenient for them
- To “schedule” time for Intra-Regional Discussions
  - We have created a format that formalizes the timing of Intra-Regional Discussions and creates space in the agenda
- To enable more opportunities for community engagement
  - We will be able to match Trustees to their closest Interactive Node, empowering them to develop community relationships
- Take the pressure off our Executive Team, Trustees and Staff
  - Individuals will only be expected to participate and support one (or max 2) sessions
  - This gives a more interesting mix of Trustees and Staff across the Global Sessions



# How our event moves with the sun

- Intra-Regional Discussions precede each Global Session
  - We have 90-Minutes allocated for the Intra-Regional Discussions; but Regions can host longer sessions if they want and there is community interest
- The timing of each Global Session is "friendly" for most in the Region

# Where is InterCommunity?

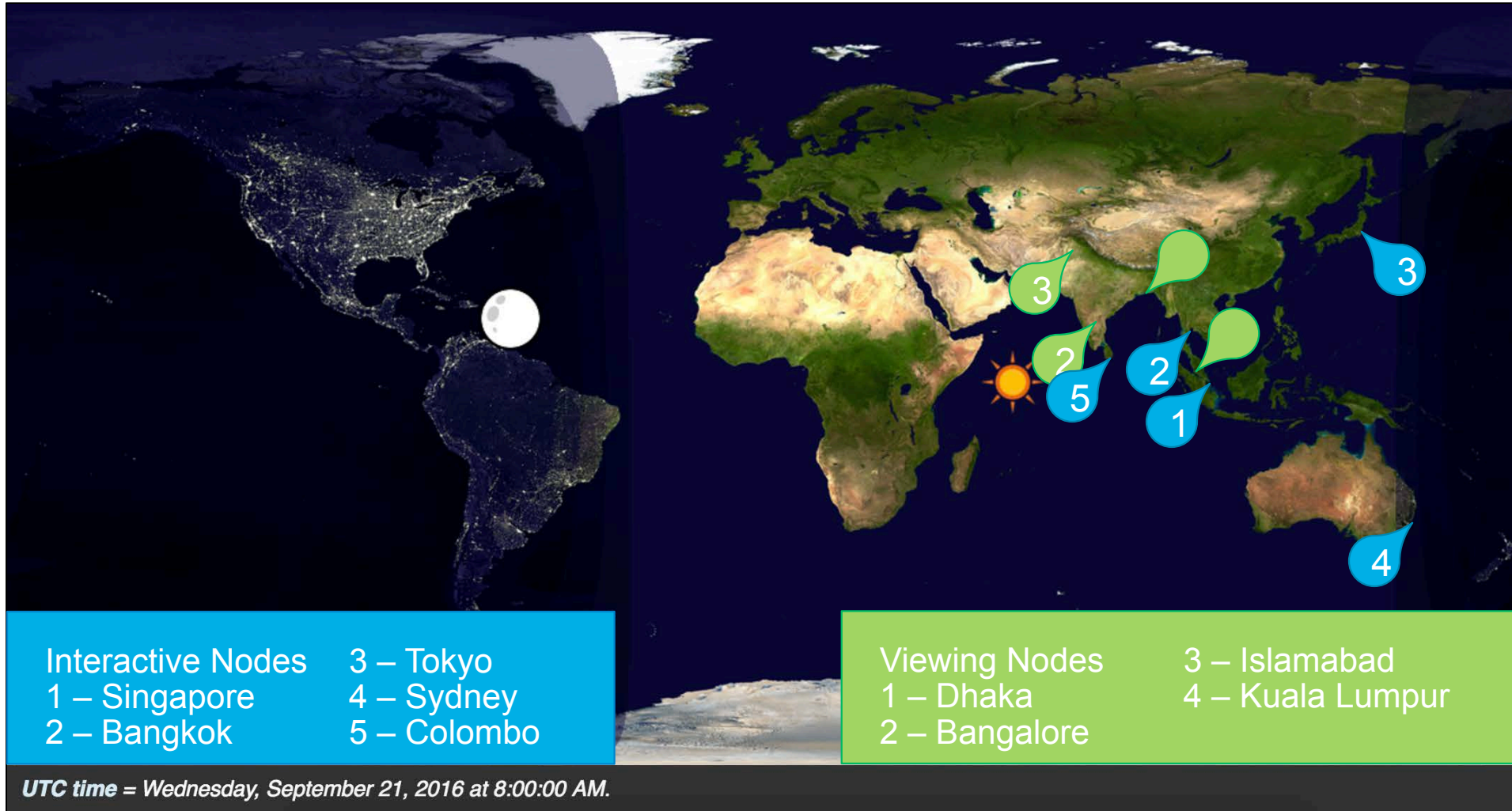
Everywhere there is Internet.

08:00 – 10:00 UTC





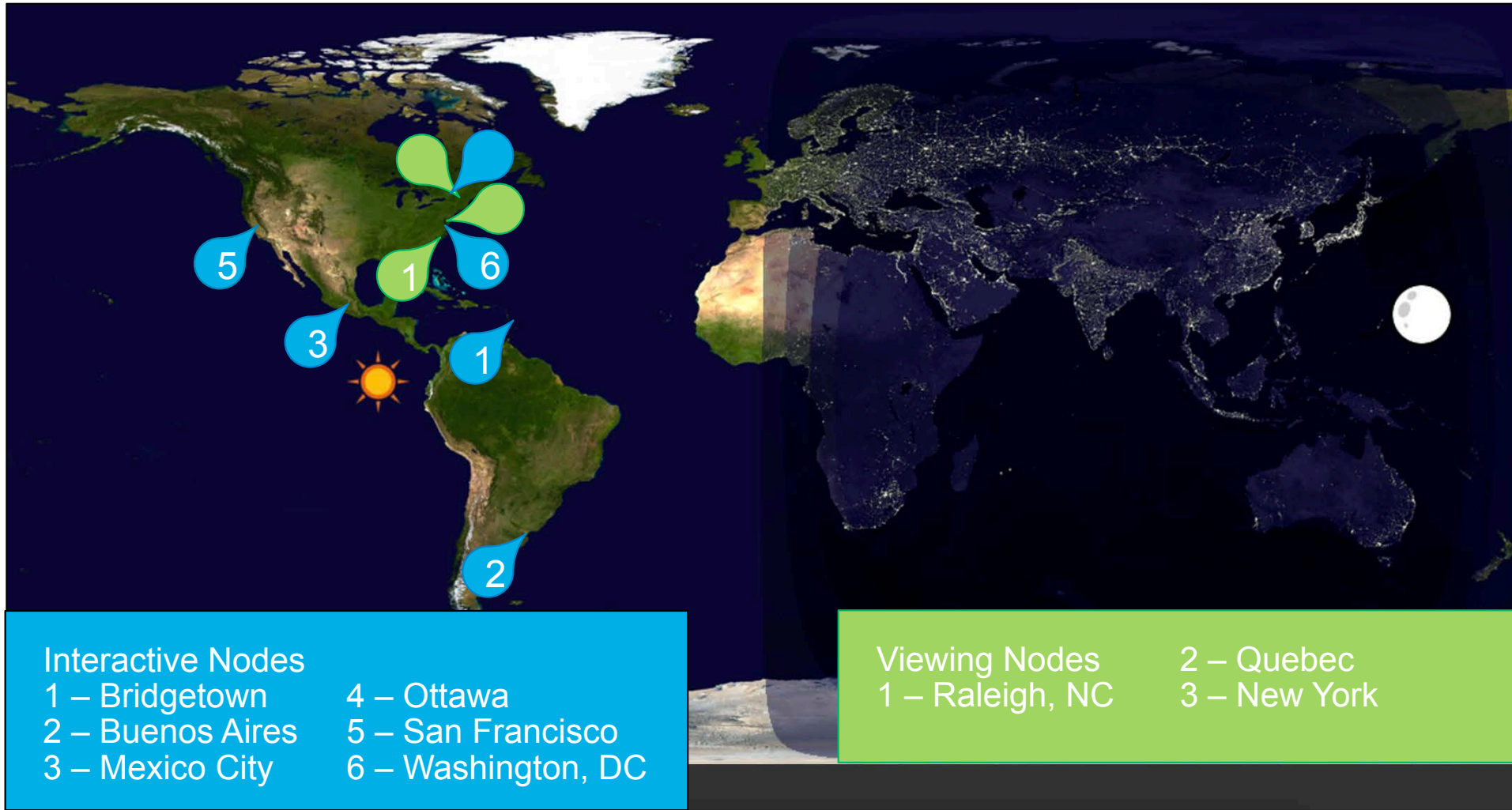
# Interactive Nodes – Global Session 2
