IETF Activity since IETF 84 (thru 30 Sep 2012)



- 1 New WG, 1 Closed WG
 - 117 WGs currently chartered
- 182 New I-Ds (26 were updated, 9 more than once)
- 443 I-Ds were updated (again, some more than once)
- 43 I-Ds with IETF Last Calls
- 41 I-Ds approved for publication
- 38 RFCs published
 - 20 Standards Track and no BCP
 - 15 Informational and 2 Experimental

- Publications: 44 (2012 to date: 261)

IANA Activity since IETF 84 (thru 30 Sep 2012)



- July: 156 tickets closed -- 97% of the protocol parameter tickets processed within the SLA goal
- August: 146 tickets closed -- 93% of the protocol parameter tickets processed within the SLA goal

IANA Activity since IETF 84 (thru 30 Sep 2012)



- Improved integration of IANA and IETF tools:
 - Working with IETF Tools Team to display the IANA state in the datatracker for approved I-Ds
 - Beta testing insertion of Last Call comments from IANA directly into the datatracker database
 - Beta testing to display datatracker states in the IANA ticketing system, which will allow IANA to move forward with closer integration of their systems with datatracker
- XML conversion of registries project coming to a close
