- + Support from LACNIC, ietf-lac group, many IETF participants

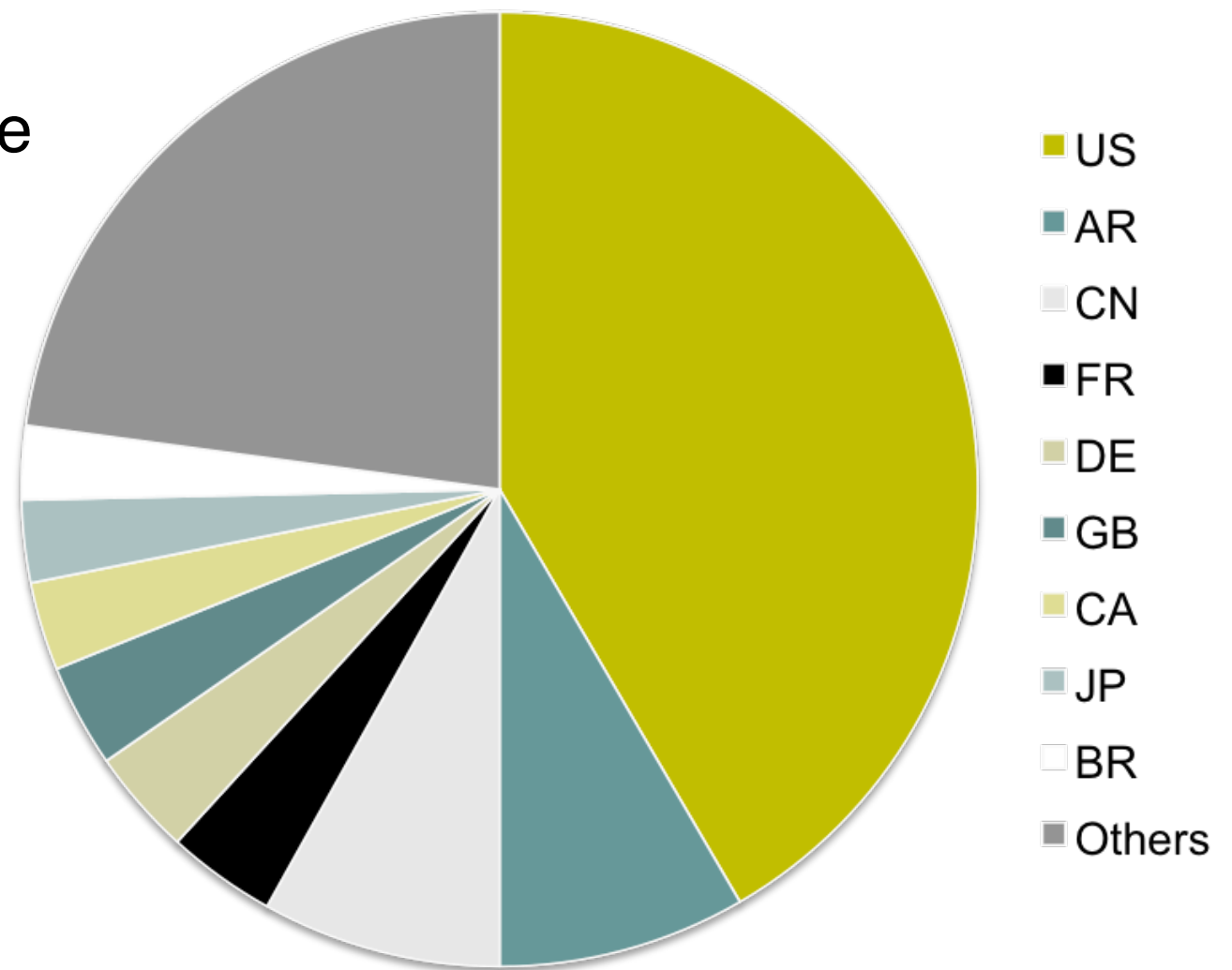
IETF 95 Participants
